| Lack of education/training to obtain good paying job | Have job training readily available. | Develop a job training/placement program with paid stipends |
| | Open more health-related jobs | Create more HIV specific job training opportunities |
| | Create Community Health Advocate programs which bring HIV+ people to promote health | Develop a peer education model which will employ HIV+ persons in the health-related field |
| | Promote independent living among HIV+ people to reduce the need for government help | Create more training opportunities for HIV+ persons in VOCREHAB that will assist them with becoming self-sufficient |
| | Engage people in vocational trainings | Create training /job placement programs specific to exoffenders to assist them with reentry into society |
| | | Create life skills program for HIV+ people |
| Loss of insurance when you lose a job | | Create a mechanism whereby HIV+ persons can retain health insurance for at least 6 months after the loss of a job |
| | CBO's should be funded to have job/vocational training programs | Reinstate training for those who want to work on the front line of HIV Prevention |
| | Apprenticeship programs for those going into the legal field | Development of a job placement/apprenticeship program that will train individuals on the job |
| | Graduates of recovery programs should be placed & guaranteed a good paying job | |
