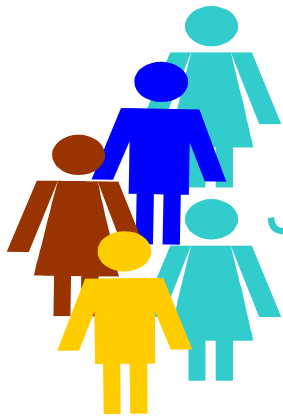
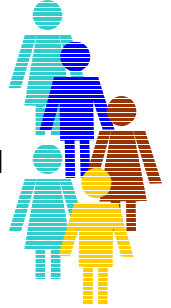


TRANS GENDER:
